Heirloom Tomato Yellow Pear (Cherry)

These pretty little pear shaped tomatoes are very mildly flavoured and beautiful in salads. The indeterminate plants will grow to 2m tall and bear hundreds of fruit until frost. 70 days. Indeterminate.



Heirloom Tomato Black Cherry

All the sweet, complex taste of a black tomato in a perfect little cherry. Prolific indeterminate plants produce loads of these dusky, juicy little tomatoes. Easy to pick and no cracking make these a favorite of gardeners. 65 days. Indeterminate.



Heirloom Tomato Red Cherry

This classic variety produces loads of delicious, juicy red cherry tomatoes that begin ripening early and keep producing all summer, north or south. The vigorous vines need to be staked. 70 days. Indeterminate.



Heirloom Tomato Red Fig (Cherry)

Plants yield hundreds of 1 1/2-inch, pear-shaped, bright-red cherry tomatoes that have wonderful, delicious, sweet flavors with a very sweet skin. Red Fig is a tasty and colorful complement to Yellow Pear. A perfect choice to serve in a tomato salad or as a tasty decoration to culinary creations and to use for making a delicious tomato chutney. 85 Days. Indeterminate.



Heirloom Tomato Reisentraube (Cherry)

German heirloom grown in North America by the Pennsylvania Dutch as early as 1856. Flavourful 2.5 cm. red cherries have a point on the blossom end and ripen in clusters of 30-50. Extremely productive. 80 days. Indeterminate.



Heirloom Tomato White Cherry

Cream-coloured, 1" fruits ripen to pale yellow and are mildly sweet. The plant is a heavy producer and the fruits combine well with darker cherry-types such as Black Cherry. 60 Days. Indeterminate.



Indigo "Blue Berries" Cherry Tomato

This open-pollinated "blue" tomato produced extremely well for us this summer. The blue-green vines are literally covered in beautiful, elongated clusters of cherry tomatoes that are a deep blue-purple when immature and ripen to a rich brick-red where exposed to the sun and purple where shaded. The fruits have a mild, sweet taste and a long shelf life. 75 days. Indeterminate



Indigo Rose Tomato

The most extraordinary, dark purple-skinned tomatoes currently available. The flavour is clean and clear, reminiscent of plums, with a slightly acidic sweetness you'll only find in home-grown tomatoes. Saladette sized fruits. 75 days. Indeterminate.



Heirloom Tomato Napoli Paste

Plant produces heavy yields of 3 to 6 oz red Italian paste-type tomatoes. They are very sweet, meaty, and juicy. Perfect for making sauce, ketchup, and paste. Also great for salads, slicing, sandwiches, soups, stir fries, canning, and freezing. 80 days. Determinate.



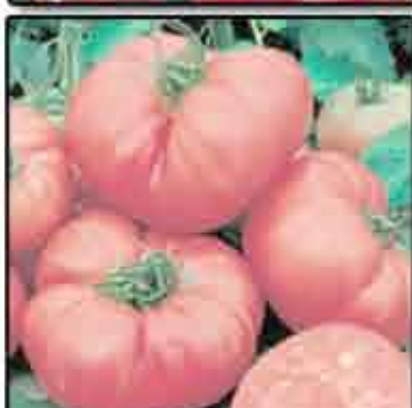
Heirloom Tomato San Marzano (Paste)

Plant produces moderate yields of 1-2 lb. smooth, pink, beefsteak fruit with very good flavor. Great slicing tomato with few seeds. 80 Days. Indeterminate.



Heirloom Tomato Beefsteak

Meaty, bright red and juicy this classic, flat-round beefsteak tomato has rich, subtly acidic, traditional tomato flavor and is great on sandwiches, burgers and salads. The vigorous vines produce high yields of large, slightly ribbed fruits all season, and need to be staked. 75 days. Indeterminate



Heirloom Tomato Ponderosa Pink (Beefsteak)

Huge size, some over 2 lbs., a meaty pink-red beefsteak fruit with very good flavor. Rich and meaty-sliced. Thick and delicious canned. 87 Days. Indeterminate.



Heirloom Tomato Brandywine Red (Potato Leaf)

A delicious descendent of the illustrious Brandywine, the gold standard of heirloom tomatoes. The large indeterminate potato leaf vines produce deep-red fruits weighing up to 2 lb. with excellent, mild, balanced heirloom flavor. 80-100 days. Indeterminate.



Heirloom Tomato Black From Tula

Largest of the black tomatoes with 3-4", slightly flattened, oblate, dark brown to purple fruit with deep green shoulders. Deliciously outstanding, rich, slightly salty, smoky-fruit flavor. 75 days. Indeterminate.



Heirloom Tomato Rouge de Marmande

A French heirloom that has an outstanding flavour with very few seeds. Clusters of deep red, slightly flattened, ribbed fruits that are up to 9 cm across. It will set fruit well in cooler conditions than other varieties. Good disease and pest resistance. 65 days. Indeterminate.



Heirloom Tomato Tigerella

Little 4oz perfectly round red tomatoes with yellow orange stripes make this tomato stand out. Plants are extremely productive and produce 5cm fruit with rich tangy flavour over a long season. 62 days. Indeterminate
